Universal Intervention:
School-Wide Preventative and Proactive Approaches for All Students

Tier 2:

Secondary Intervention: Targeted to Smaller Groups of Students Identified as At-Risk Through Local Progress Monitoring

Tier 3:

Intensive Intervention:
Driven by SST, Individualized Instruction and Progress Monitoring of Students who are not Responding to Secondary Interventions

Tier 4:

Special Education Intervention:
Alternative Instruction or Placement to Target Severe or Chronic Academic or Behavioral Concerns


